Criteria Applicants must: -

1. be enrolled in a B.Ed. in Early Childhood Education programme at Shortwood Teachers' College.
2. maintain a minimum Grade Point Average of 3.0 at the end of each semester.
3. meet required class attendance criteria set by college.
4. complete:
 - scholarship application form.
 - an essay (*not more than 500 words*) outlining aspects of personal background, interests, and educational goals.
 - an explanation of your financial challenges.

N.B.: The Scholarship may be rescinded if the student is in receipt of another such award, is found to have presented false or misleading information or fails to maintain other aspects of eligibility.

Type This is a full scholarship offered to final year students pursuing a Bachelor of Education Degree in Early Childhood Education

Value 1. The scholarship pays Tuition



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2. An additional one-time grant may be given to assist a student in meeting Tuition /Boarding needs

Duration The scholarship will last from the date of award until the completion of the academic year of the Bachelor's degree currently enrolled.

Disbursement Payments will be disbursed by cheque or electronic transfer to the College's Bank Account at the beginning of each academic year on behalf of the recipient.

Disbursements will be made after verification by the College that the conditions of the scholarship are being upheld by the student.

Application Process

- Advertisement for scholarship will be published by the College's Registry on behalf of the Donor Agent
- Application forms will be accessed through the office of the College's Registrar
- Advertisements will be placed online, on the College's notice Board and via campus clubs and societies and via students' College email.
- Completed application package must be submitted to the office of the College Registrar.
- Deadline for submission of applications is July 31st annually
- The successful applicant will be informed by August 31st annually
