#### What is Erasmus+ KA171 (International Credit Mobility)?

The Erasmus+ KA171 programme facilitates international credit mobility, allowing students from partner countries to **study or train at European universities**. This initiative promotes **personal and professional development** while enhancing the **internationalization of higher education**.

#### Target Group

**Eligibility:** This call is open to **two (2) outgoing Bachelor's students** for a **one-semester (4-month) learning mobility** during the **Fall Semester of the 2025/2026 academic year**.

#### **Features of the Mobility for Outgoing Students**

- ✓ Academic Relevance: Mobility studies must align with the student's degree program.
- ✓ Language Requirement: Spanish language proficiency at B1 level is required.
- ✓ **Financial Support:** The grant covers **travel expenses** and provides a **stipend** for the duration of the stay.
- **✓ Duration:** Maximum **4 months**.
