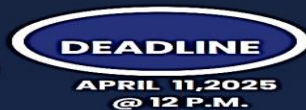

- Semester:** Fall 2025/2026 Academic Year

### What is Erasmus+ KA171 (International Credit Mobility)?

The Erasmus+ KA171 programme facilitates international credit mobility, allowing students from partner countries to **study or train at European universities**. This initiative promotes **personal and professional development** while enhancing the **internationalization of higher education**.

### Target Group

**Eligibility:** This call is open to **two (2) outgoing Bachelor's students** for a **one-semester (4-month) learning mobility** during the **Fall Semester of the 2025/2026 academic year**.

### Features of the Mobility for Outgoing Students

- ✓ **Academic Relevance:** Mobility studies must align with the student's degree program.
- ✓ **Language Requirement:** Spanish language proficiency at B1 level is required.
- ✓ **Financial Support:** The grant covers **travel expenses** and provides a **stipend** for the duration of the stay.
- ✓ **Duration:** Maximum **4 months**.

### Grant Details

- Subsistence Grant:** €3,400 (paid in **two installments**).
- Travelling Assistance:** €820 per participant.
