Award Amount: \$100,000 JMD (Annually)

Programme: Bachelor of Education (B.E.D) in Secondary Education

Eligibility Criteria:

1. Enrollment Status:

- Applicant must be a full-time student registered in the B.Ed. in Secondary Education programme at Shortwood Teachers' College.

2. Academic Performances:

- Must have a minimum GPA 2.7 on a 4.3 scale
- Must demonstrate consistent academic excellent and a commitment to teaching

3. Financial Needs

- Preferences will be given to students who demonstrate financial needs. Applicant may be required to submit proof of financial status.

4. Leadership & Community Involvement:

- Must exhibit strong leadership qualities and active participation in school-related or community-based activity.

5. Personal Statement:

- Applicants must submit a 500-words essay outlining their passion for teaching, career goals and how the scholarship will impact their educational journey.

6. Recommendation Letters:

- Two letters of recommendation are required:
 - One from a faculty member or lecture at Shortwood Teachers' College
 - One from a mentor, employer, or community leader who can attest to the applicant's character and leadership abilities.

7. Interview (if applicable):

- Shortlisted candidate may be required to participate in an interview with the scholarship selection committee.

Application Process:

- Application must be submitted by June 30, 2026 each year.
- Required documents include:

Completed application form
Academic transcript
Proof of financial need (if applicable)
Personal statement
Two recommendation letters

Selection Process:

- The scholarship committee will review application based on academic merit, financial need, leadership potential, and the quality of the personal statement.
- The recipient will be announced by August 30, 2026 and will be required to attend an award presentation ceremony.
